2. Any work may be entered that relates to the theme: "Our Sense of Place". This show is part of a weekend long family event and as such, no nudes, or works of art that might be considered of an 'offensive nature' will be accepted.

3. Sales of artwork are encouraged. Each individual artist is responsible for the collection/payment of Maine State sales tax.

4. The show will run from approximately 9:00am - 6:00pm on August 8th, 2009. The gym will be open 2 hours early for set up. Each artist is responsible for their artwork in this show. There will be a sign-up for artists to take turns watching the gym - hopefully just an hour each. Artwork may not be left unattended.
